That DAYTON SAVINGS & TRUST COMPANY; Trustee, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Ohio, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby released, convey and quit-claim unto The Lawrence Railway and Light Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Kansas, with principal office and place of business at Lawrence, in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, and to its successors and assigns, all right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever it may have acquired in, thru or by a certain Mortgage or Deed of Trust, bearing date the 1st day of June, 1909, and recorded in the Register's Office of Douglas County, Kansas on the 20 th day of December, 1909, in Volume 47, page 459, to all the premises, rights, privileges, franchises and property, contracts and leases therein described or referred to, and situate in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, and particularly those certain premises described as follows:

- (1) Lots 11 and 12 and Lots 23 and 24, in Block 16, in Babcock's Enlarged Addition to the City of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas, Kansas;
 - (2) Beginning at a point 35.2 feet South of the North West corner of Lot E, in Block one (1), University Place, an addition to the City of Lawrence, on the East Line of Conklin Street in said Addition; thence running Southeasterly, making an angle of 140 degrees 05 minutes turned East from the East line of said Conklin Street, 129.8 feet; thence curving to the left, with a radius of 95.3 feet, a distance of 85.1 feet to an intersection with a line 20 feet North of the South line of lot B in said Block one (1) University Place, and parallel thereto; thence Easterly along said line to the East line of said Lot B, to the South line of said Lot B to a point 158.1 feet from the South West corner of said Lot B; thence curving to the right with a radius of 115.3 feet a distance of 102.7 feet; thence on a tangent Northwesterly 109.3 feet to the East line of Conklin Street; thence Northerly along the East line of Conklin Street 31.2 feet to the place of beginning;
