KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mary E. B. B. Haskell, party of the second part, dated June 22, 1915, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, in Book 54, at page 35, of the Mortgage Records of said County, is, as to the following part and portion of the property therein does described, to-wit:-

Beginning at a point on the West line of Section 32, T. 12 S., R. 20 E. of the 6th P.
