This Indenture, Made this twenty second day of January in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and seventeen, between Amelia Gummerman and M. R. Gummerman husband and wife of North Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Hugh Blair of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Seventy-five DOLLARS, to —— duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha —— sold, and by these presents do —— grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Commencing at the North west corner of the North East quarter of the South west quarter of the North west quarter of section twenty nine (29) Township No. twelve Range No. twenty two in addition to twenty seven (27) North Lawrence now a part of the City of Lawrence. Thence East 132 feet, thence South 330 feet, thence West 132 feet thence North 330 feet to beginning. Containing one acre. The mortgagors agree to keep the buildings on premises insured against Fire, Lightning & Wind Storm & to let out of them insurable Office in a company approved of by the mortgagor with witness cause attached making less payable in said mortgage or his assigns as interest may appear, and failing to do so holder of mortgage may have same insured and the cost of so doing added to the mortgage to show interest until paid at 10%.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof —— they one —— the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three hundred and Seventy-five (375⁰⁰) Dollars according to the terms of the certain Note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first, the mortgagors to the said party of the second part the Mortgagor. Payable three years after date of date of said Mortgage at the Merchants National Bank in Lawrence with interest according to coupons attached to note until its maturity, and rate of 10%, and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns and it is expressly understood and agreed that default in payment of interest shall not affect this mortgage except both principal and interest.
