to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha re sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Part of Lot number one (1) and Two (2), of the Northeast fractional quarter(s), of Section Two (2), Township Twelve (12) Range Eighteen (18) East of 6th P.M., Beginning at a point 12.81 chains west of the Southeast corner of North-East quarter (4) of Section 2, Township 12, Range 18, thence west 4.60 chains, thence North 35.50 chains to the right bank of the Kansas River; thence down said river to A.M. Day's west line; thence South along said line 130 rods to place of beginning, containing 16 acres more or less. Also, beginning at a point 9.61 chains west of the Southeast corner of the North-East fractional quarter(s) of Section 2, Township 12, Range 18, East of 6th P.M., thence west 3.70 chains, thence north 17.50 chains to a point to foot of hill; thence south, 54 degrees east, 4.13 chains to a post; thence South 14.40 chains to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres more or less, in said County and State, less half acre railroad right of way crossing said tracts of land.

But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of the first part their heirs and assigns.
