This Indenture, Made this Third day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred eighteen, between Charles H. Larcom and Rose Larcom his wife of Lawrence City, of Missouri, in the County of Jackson, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Hugh Blair of city of Lawrence Douglas County Kansas, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part ie of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Five hundred DOLLARS,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha are sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Beginning forty (40) rods west of the North East corner of the Northwest quarter of Section No. twenty seven (27) in Township no. twelve (12) of Range No. 19, thence South fifty (50) rods, thence West Eighty (80) rods, thence North fifty (50) rods, thence East Eighty (80) rods to place of beginning containing .55 acres.

The Mortgagor agree to keep the buildings on premises now erected or to be hereafter erected, insured against fire, lightning and windstorms to the extent of their insurable value in a company approved by the mortgagor, his agent or assigns, with mortgage clause attached making less payable to said mortgagee or assigns, as interest may appear and failing to do so holder of mortgage may have same insured and the cost of so doing added to the note and mortgage to draw interest until paid at some late as Justice bears.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part ie of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, save a first mortgage for \$2000. to Blenda P. Greenwood of even date herewith.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

Five hundred dollars, according to the terms of one certain Note, this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said part of the second part payable five years after date with interest at 6% according to coupons attached to said note.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insuree is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of making such sale, on demand, to said parties of first part heirs and assigns.
