

MORTGAGE RECORD NO. 55.

This Indenture, Made this Twelfth day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and eighteen, between John Moody and Mary Moody, his wife, of Endless Top, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and E. M. Roberts of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand \$ 2000 DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha. 22 sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of the second part her heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: The North half of the N.E. 1/4 of Section Seven (7) Township Thirtieth (30) Range Twenty-one (21), on the North side of the Wakarusa River, described as follows: beginning at the Northwest corner of said forty acres, thence South to the Wakarusa River, thence down said river toward its mouth to the place where said river crosses the section line running east and west on the North of said forty (40) acres, thence west on said section line to the place of beginning, containing Seven and three fourths (.75) acres more or less; also The West half of the East half of the North east quarter of Section Thirty-six (36) Township Thirtieth (30) Range Twenty-one (21) containing 30 acres more or less. See 36 being fractional.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof, they the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four Thousand \$ 2000 dollars according to the terms of one certain Note this day executed, and delivered by the said John Moody and Mary Moody to the said part of the second part bearing interest from date payable semi-annually at the rate of 6 percent per annum due and payable five years after date, and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
