

MORTGAGE RECORD NO. 55.

This Indenture, Made this 18th day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and eighteen, between Charles J. Coffin and Anna L. Coffin, his wife, of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, of the first part, and Hugh Blair of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred DOLLARS,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the south west corner of northeast quarter of section Nineteen (19), Township Thirteen (13), Range Twenty (20), thence north fifty-eight and a half (58.5) rods, thence North Twenty-two (22) rods, five and 50/100 feet, thence South fifty-eight and a half (58.5) rods, thence South top of beginning, five (5) rods more or less, etc.

Beginning at a point four hundred and fifty-one and 50/100 feet North of south west corner of said northeast quarter (1/4) of section Nineteen (19), Township Thirteen (13), Range Twenty (20), thence North Forty-five and 130/100 (45.13) feet, thence East Fifty-eight and 50/100 (58.5) rods, thence South Forty-five and 130/100 (45.13) feet, thence East Fifty-eight and 50/100 (58.5) rods to place of beginning, one acre more or less.

The mortgagor agrees to keep the building on premises insured against fire, lightning, and windstorms to the value of their insurable value in sum of \$1000.00, the mortgagee being liable for loss payable to said mortgagee, or assignee, interest may accrue, and failing to do so, the holder of mortgage may have same incurred and the cost of collecting added to the mortgage.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Six hundred Dollars

according to the terms of one certain Note this day executed.

and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part Payable three years after date with interest thereon according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
