

MORTGAGE RECORD NO. 55.

This Indenture, Made this 15th day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and eighteen, between Walter O. M. Blanchard, and Alice Hazel M. Blanchard, his wife of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Hugh Blair of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part... of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party... of the second part... his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Begin at a convenient place which is 10 chains more or less of the southeast corner of the tract of fractional quarter of Section 12, in Township 12 South of Range 18 East of the 6th P.M. in said County and State, thence North on the quarter section line 12 chains and 9 links to the south east corner of a tract of land owned by M.D. Sealwell and wife, B. B. Birmingham (recorded in Book 32, page 133 of the records of said County) at 12.12 chains more or less East of the southwest corner of the quarter section; thence North parallel with the said line of the quarter section 35 chains to the Right of the R.R. of M.D. Sealwell thence South 55th 45th East 12 chains 7.57 links to the line of the aforesaid division fence; thence South 27 chains 7.50 links to place of beginning containing 3 acres more or less and beginning at a point 7.61 chains East of a corner of M.E. fractional quarter of Sec. 12, T. 12 S. R. 18 E. thence West 370 chains, thence North 705 chains to a point at foot of hill; thence South 54th East 4.13 chains to a post; thence North 47.43 chains to place of beginning containing 3 acres more or less less or more R.R. Right of way, also Part of lot No. 173 of T. 12 S. fractional quarter of Sec. 12, T. 12 S. R. 18 E. beginning at a point 12.51 chains west of S.E. corner of M.E. quarter of Sec. 12, T. 12 S. R. 18 E. thence North 4.66 chains; thence North 35.50 chains to the right bank of Stone Creek; thence down said river to S.M. Depew's line; thence South along said line 130 rods to beginning, containing 16 acres more or less less or more R.R. Right of way.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part... of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Five hundred Dollars according to the terms of one certain note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part payable three years after date with interest thereon according to the terms of said note and coupons thereto attached and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payments or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
