

## MORTGAGE RECORD NO. 55.

This Indenture, Made this 24th day of November, in the year of our Lord ninetynine hundred seventeen, between Barney L. Traynor and Gladys Traynor, husband and wife, of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and

The Farmers State and Savings Bank of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty (700.00) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have been sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part 2d of the second part, its successors, heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

(Beginning Fifty (50) feet west of the Southeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Sixty (60) South of Range Twenty (20) East of the 6th P.M. in North Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, thence North One hundred fifty (150) feet, thence west Fifty (50) feet, thence South One hundred fifty (150) feet, thence east Fifty (50) feet to beginning (beginning west Fifty (50) feet of the East One hundred (100) feet of the South One hundred Fifty (150) feet of the tract of land deeded to Bryant, as per deed recorded in Book 90, page 519, in Register's Office of Douglas County, said tract of land measuring 150 feet from East to West by standard measure.)

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part 1st of the first part therein. And the said Barney L. Traynor and Gladys Traynor do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof, they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances. (I have understood that this mortgage is a part of the purchase price of said property.)

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty (700) Dollars, according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Barney L. Traynor and Gladys Traynor to the said part 1st of the second part

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment; or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part 2d of the second part, its successors, executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part 1st making such sale, on demand, to said

heirs and assigns.
