TO HAVE AND HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the reeements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in
 any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYES, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of

One hundred and no 00/100 DOLLARS,
 with interest and premium thereon, and such dues and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the con-
 tract more fully hereby, agreed by the said THE Lawrence Building and Loan Association to the party of the first part,
 upon shares of Class 1000 of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 259, which said
 shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said
 shares, the first party agrees to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$11.43, payable as follows:
Eleven and 43/100 Dollars (\$ 11.43) on or before the last day of April, 1926,
 and a like sum on or before the last day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of March, 1927.

Now if said party of the first part shall fail to pay to the party of the second part the amount due it under said contract note, in accordance
 with the terms thereof, and timely with all the provisions and agreements in said note contained, then these present shall be void; otherwise in full force
 and effect, and may be foreclosed as in said contract note provided.
