

MORTGAGE RECORD

This Indenture Made this 22 day of November A. D. 1918, between

Lula Harmon and her husband, Lewis Harmon

of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and THE Douglas County BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of LAWRENCE, KAN SAS, of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do

assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to-wit: Beginning at a point Twenty (20) rods West from the South-East corner of the South-West quarter of the North-West quarter of Section No. Twenty Nine (29), in Township No. Twelve (12), South, of Range No. Twenty (20) East of the 6th R.M. thence running that Thirty Five (35) feet, thence North to the right of way of the Union Pacific Railroad, thence Northwesterly along said right of way about Thirty Five (35) feet to a point due North of the place of beginning, thence South to the place of beginning, being a portion of the South Half of Section No. Seven (7), in that part of the City of Lawrence, known as North Lawrence.

TO HAVE AND HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of

Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS, with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the contract note secured hereby, advanced by the said THE Douglas County BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the parties of the first part upon 25 shares of Class A of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 3028 which said shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said shares, the first part will agree to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$ 7.95, payable as follows: Seven and 95/100 Dollars, (\$ 7.95) on or before the 15 day of November 1918 and a like sum on or before the 22 day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of October 1921.

Now, if said parties of the first part shall cause to be paid to the party of the second part the amount due it under said contract note, in accordance with the terms thereof, and comply with all the provisions and agreements in said note contained, then these presents shall be void; otherwise in full force and effect, and may be foreclosed as in said contract note provided.
