PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of-

Twenty-five Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the contract now secured hereby, advanced by said TIE SURETY to the BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION for the part of the first part upon 2500.00 of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 349, which said shares have been sold to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said shares of the first part shall agree to pay, in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$ 21.75, payable as follows: Twenty one and 75/100 Dollars, (\$ 21.75) or before the last day of April 1922
and the sum on or before the 1st day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of March 1922
