WITNESSETH: That the part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Twenty-four Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto said party of the second part, its successors and

assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot Number Ten (10), Block Twenty-six (26) of Sinclair's Addition
to the city of Lawrence.

TO HAVE AND HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in
any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of

Twenty-four Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,

with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the con-

tract note secured hereby, advanced by the said THE LAWRENCE BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the part of the first

part upon 24 shares of Class of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 462 which said

shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said

shares, the first part agree to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$32.48, payable as follows:

Thirty and 48/100 Dollars, (\$32.48) on or before the last day of May 1922

and a like sum on or before the last day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of April 1922
