

## PARTIAL RELEASE.

Know all men by these presents, that I, Mary E. B. Haskell, the mortgagee in the certain mortgage deed hereinafter mentioned and described, do hereby certify that, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-two Dollars (\$1,262.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said mortgage deed, made and executed by Irving Hill, Trustee, as party of the first part, to me, Mary E. Begin at an iron pin in the east line of and Forty-six feet (46') South of the north-east corner of the South-east Quarter of the south-west quarter of Section thirty-two (32), in Township Twelve (12) S. of Range Twenty (20) E. of the 6th P.M. in Douglas County, Kansas, thence West one hundred and sixty-eight (168) feet to an iron pin; thence south parallel with said east line seven hundred and Sixty-one and one-half (761.5) feet to an iron pin in the North line of Oak Hill Avenue; Thence S. 78° 56' E. on said line of Oak Hill Avenue One Hundred and Seventy-one and two-tenths (171.2) feet to an iron pin in the East line of the Quarter Section; thence North Seven Hundred and Ninety-three and Seventy-five One-hundredths (793.75) feet to the beginning, containing Three acres.
