**WITNESSETH** That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Two thousand DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part its heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: The northwesterly quarter of section number Twenty, in Township number fourteen, south of range number twenty one, each, subject to first mortgage of \$2000 payable to the Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Co.

Three years days after date, I, was either of us promised to pay to the order of State Bank of Eudora, at its office in Eudora, Kansas, Two Thousand Dollars, with interest at the rate of six per cent, commencing from date until due, to be received quarterly payable semi-annually, interest rate of six per cent, per annum after maturity. We the makers, indorsees, assignees and sureties severally waive presentment for payment demand, protest and notice of protest, for non-payment of this note. H.A. Eller, No. 142, Due 1st & 15th Dec. 1921. Because stamp 40 cents. Oliver M. Eller with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said H.A. Eller and Oliver M. Eller, his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances except a first mortgage of \$2000.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, according to the terms of one certain note this day executed and delivered by the said H.A. Eller and Oliver M. Eller to the said party of the second part The State Bank of Eudora.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, its executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said

heirs and assigns.
