

## MORTGAGE RECORD NO. 58

This Indenture, Made this 15th day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred nineteen between Leon N. Flink and Elizabeth B. Flink, husband and wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and The Fraternal Aid Union, a corporation, of Lawrence in County of Douglas and the State of Kansas of the second part:

WITNESSETH That the said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four thousand, five hundred and no/100 DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part 2d of the second part to successors heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Three (3) in South Lawrence in the City of Lawrence, also a tract described as follows: commencing forty (40) rods South of the North East corner of Section One (1) in Township Thirteen (13) Range Nineteen (19), thence South one hundred and ten (110) feet; thence West ten (10) rods; thence North one hundred and ten (110) feet; thence East ten (10) rods; to the place of beginning except however the North Twelve (12) feet now in 16th Street and less that part on the east end now in Louisiana Street and subject to right of way for sewer here to you granted to the City of Lawrence.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part 1st of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and infeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four Thousand + five hundred + no/100 according to the terms of their certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Leon N. Flink and Elizabeth B. Flink to the said part 2d of the second part said note matures five years from this date and bears interest at the rate of six percent per annum, payable semi-annually with option to pay 50% in money any time or principal and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payments or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part 2d of the second part, its successors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there is, shall be paid by the part 2d making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
