 Hugh Blais of the second part:

WITNESSETH That the said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand DOLLARS,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit Beginning at a stone 2135 feet north of the south west corner of the northwest fractional quarter of Section 22, Township 12, Range 2, and 300 feet East of the west line of said Section which said fractional quarter tract and 300 feet East of the west line contains 51 and 52 acres the right bank of the Kansas River; the Magnetic variation 2 degrees and 35 minutes East, back 45 degrees East 212 feet to a stone, thence back 49 degrees 20 minutes East 535 feet to a stone, thence back 60 degrees East 235 feet to a stone, thence back 74 degrees East 215 feet to a stone in the east boundary line of the several estates undivided, thence back 60 degrees East 215 feet northerly to the north line of the right of way of the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company, thence back along said right of way 1640 feet to a stone 2135 degrees North 215 feet, thence North 215 feet due along the north line of said right of way 550 feet further north to the east line of said quarter section, thence North and parallel thereto and line of said quarter section 1300 feet to the point of beginning, containing 51 acres plus 52 acres the right title retained in the right of way agreement recorded in Vol. 102, page 23 in Register of Deeds Office, Douglas Co., Kansas, on Aug. 24, 1918.

do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

Three thousand dollars

according to the terms of one certain note this day executed

and delivered by the said part of the first part to the said part of the second part payable three years after date with interest thereon according to the terms of said note and coupon thereto attached.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payments or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of the first part making such sale, on demand, to the part of the first part their heirs and assigns.
