

## MORTGAGE RECORD NO. 58

This Indenture, Made this Fifth day of August in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and nineteen, between Arthur Fritzel and Missie M. Fritzel his wife, of the Township of Haskins in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and

Jesse Blair of the second part:

WITNESSETH That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred DOLLARS,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: The Southeast quarter(1/4) of the Northeast quarter(1/4) of the Southwest quarter(1/4) of Section One in Township Thirteen (13) of Range Nineteen (19) in said County and State, containing Two(2) acres. Also the west half(1/2) of the West half(1/2) of the Southwest quarter(1/4) of the Northwest quarter(1/4) of the South East quarter(1/4) of said Section One (1), Township Thirteen (13), Range Nineteen (19), containing Two and a half(2 1/2) acres, less Railroad Right of Way

The mortgagors agree to keep the buildings on premises insured against fire, lightning and wind storm to the extent of their insurable value in a company approved of by the mortgagor with mortgage clause attached making loss payable to said mortgagor, or his assignee, as interest may appear, and failing to do so holder of mortgage may have same incurred and the cost of doing added to the mortgage to draw interest unchaged at 10% with all the appearances and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Eighteen hundred Dollars

according to the terms of one certain note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part Payable thirty-six months after date with interest thereon according to terms of said note

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payments or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part

their heirs and assigns. This mortgage is given as additional and collateral security to a certain mortgage on personal property made and between the same parties of even date hereto set forth.
