This Indenture, Made this Fourth day of December, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and Nineteen, between Charles C. Edgar and Mabel M. Edgar, his wife, of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and

WITNESSETH That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred DOLLARS,

to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The South Five (5) feet of Lot number Fifty-five (55) and all of Lot number Fifty-seven (57) on Rhode Island street, in the City of Lawrence, said County and State.

The mortgagor agree to keep the buildings upon premises insured against fire, lightning and wind storm to the extent of their insurable value, and a company or companies approved of by the mortgagor with mortgage clause attached making loss payable to said mortgagee, or assignee, as interest may appear, and failing to do so holder of mortgage may have same insured and the cost of so doing added to the mortgage.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part

do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner(s) of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars according to the terms of one certain note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part payable five years after date with interest thereon according to the terms of said note and coupon thereto attached.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
