 Witnesseth, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) and 00 DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, here
 heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:

Beginning at the south east corner of the south west quarter of section thirty-two (32) township twelve (12) range twenty (20) thence North four hundred and nine (409) feet to the south line of the Cemetery road, thence along the south line of said road in an easterly direction two hundred and seven (207) feet to a stake, thence South four hundred forty eight (448) feet thence East two hundred three and three fourths (203 $\frac{3}{4}$) feet to a place of beginning containing one acre more or less, being the two following described tract or tract. Now, If said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, here heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable; then the whole of said sum and sums and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents, become due and payable and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
