Witnesseth, That said part one of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Five Thousand \$500.00 DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part one of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit:

The South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North East quarter (N.E. 4) of Section Seven (S. 7), Township Fifteen (T. 15), Range Eighteen (R. 18), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian.

To Have and to Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever:

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said Christ Straub and Flora Straub

have one this day executed and delivered one certain promissory note in writing to said part one of the second part, of which the following is a copy of \$5000.00

Overbrook, Kansas, February 26, 1925
Five years after date, for value received, we or either of us, promise to pay to the order of G. Oehle, Five Thousand \$500.00 Dollars, at The Douglas State Bank, Overbrook, Kansas; with interest at 6 percent, from date until paid.

Signed in due and proper form, witness, demand, protest and notice of non-payment.

Privilege to pay \$100.00 or more on principal at any interest payment.

Now, If said part one of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part one of the second part, his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable; then the whole of said sum and sums and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents, become due and payable and said part one of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
