Witnesseth, That said parties, of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Twelve Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, its successors
heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:

Lot one hundred thirty-five (135) and the East 40 feet of lot one hundred thirty-four (134) on Indiana Street, Baldwin City, Douglas County, Kansas.

To Have and to Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever:
Provided Always, And these presents are upon the express condition, that the said party of the second part, shall pay to said party of the first part, the sum of

Twelve Hundred and Fifty Dollars, with interest thereon, and such sum as may be due, on the day hereinafter and delivered, in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following

charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the contract note secured hereby, advanced by the said The State Savings and Loan Association to the parties of the first part upon 12 1/2 shares of Class F of the capital stock of said Association evidenced by Certificate No. 9 which said shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest and dues on shares, the first parties agree to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$17.05 payable as follows: Seventeen and 05/100 Dollars on or before the 25th day of March, 1924 and a like sum on or before the 25th day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of February, 1934.

Now, If said parties of the first part shall fail to pay to the party of the second part, the amount due it, under said contract note, in accordance with the terms thereof, and comply with all the above described notes, covenants and conditions together with the intent thereon, according to the terms and intent of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged, and the party of the second part shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, or if the dues and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable; then the whole of said sum and sums and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents, become due and payable and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the recovery of said premises.
