Witnesseth, That said part ies of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Fourteen Hundred Thirty Four and $\frac{1}{2}$ DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas:

Beginning at a point where the center of County road intersects the east line of the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Five (5) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty One (1). Hence running West 55° 45' Lat. Hence back to a point 15' feet south of the center of a ravine; thence in a True Easterly direction 556 feet more or less to a point 230 feet North of the South East corner of the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Number Two.
