Witnesseth, That said parties, of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred & no/100

DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part of the second part, their
heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of lots Eighty-four (84) and Eighty-six (86) and the
South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the East forty feet (40 ft.) of lot Eighty-eight
(88) on Grove Street in Baldwin City in Douglas County, Kansas.

To Have and to Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever:

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said Maud A. Harrison and Earl H. Harrison, her husband, have this day executed and delivered one certain promissory note, in writing to said part of the second part, of which the following is a copy: Baldwin City, Kansas, March 21, 1932. On or before April, 1935, for value received, we promise to pay to the order of the Board of Conference Claimants of the Kansas Annual Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church the principal sum of Eighteen Hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America with interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum, payable semi-annually on the last day of October and April in each year, according to the tenor of this unpayable until due, bearing interest thereon. Both principal and interest notes payable at Baldwin City, Kansas; and if any interest coupon or any part thereof is not paid when due, the principal and accrued interest shall become due and payable at once, at the option of the legal holder of this note. This note and these coupons to bear six percent interest per annum after maturity, or default in payment of any interest. All usages, ements and stay laws are hereby waived. It is agreed that the sum of \$100.00 or any multiple thereof, may be paid monthly principal of this note at the maturity of any interest coupons.

Now, If said part of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part of the second part, less or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note, mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable; then the whole of said sum and sums and interest thereon, shall and by these presents, become due and payable and said part of the second part, and said parties, will have and hold full right and power over any and all the premises herein contained, or any part thereof, to pay the sum and interest, or any part thereof, or any assessment or tax assessed, attorney fees for the enforcement of this mortgage, shall be entitled to the possession of said premises, which sum shall be a few days past due, and interest, and taxes, and assessments, and all other charges, and secured by these presents, and shall be includable and owing to said part of the first part, as aforesaid, on the day and year first above written.
