This Indenture, Made this 21st day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred + twenty three, between Gella P. Page a single woman of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and

Wattkins National Bank of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said part y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred DOLLARS, to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has she sold, and by these presents does she grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part y of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Lot No. Thirty one (31) on Connecticut Street City of Lawrence.

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part y of the first part therein. And the said

Gella P. Page does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she the lawful owner... of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that she will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven Hundred DOLLARS, according to the terms of a certain promissory note... this day executed by said Gella P. Page

to the said part y of the second part; said note being given for the sum of

Seven Hundred DOLLARS, dated June 21, 1923, due and payable in one year from date thereof,

with interest thereon from the date thereof until paid according to the terms of said note and two coupons of 24 50 / 100 Dollars each thereto attached. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as in said note and coupons thereto attached, and as hereinafter specified. And the said part y of the first part hereby agree to pay all taxes assessed on said premises before any penalties or costs shall accrue on account thereof, and to keep the said premises insured in favor of said mortgage, in the sum of Eight hundred DOLLARS,

in some insurance company satisfactory to said mortgage, in default whereof the said mortgage may pay the taxes and accruing penalties, interests and costs, and insure the same at the expense of the part y of the first part, and the expense of such taxes and accruing penalties, interest and costs, and insurance, shall, from the payment thereof, be and become an additional lien under this mortgage upon the above described premises, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof or interest thereon or the taxes assessed on said premises or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole principal of said note... and interest thereon, and all taxes and accruing penalties and interest and costs thereon remaining unpaid or which may have been paid by the part y of the second part, and all sums paid by the part y of the second part for insurance, shall be due and payable or not, at the option of the part y of the second part; and it shall be lawful for the part y of the second part, its successors, administrators or assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not, at the option of the part y of the second part, its successors or assigns, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due or to become due according to the conditions of this instrument, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the over-plus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part y of the second part, its successors or assigns, on demand, to the said Gella P. Page heirs and assigns.
