

MORTGAGE RECORD NO. 60

This Indenture, Made this 7th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred twenty three, between Alvin Miller, English, and William H. England, his husband, of the County of and State of Kansas, of the first part, and The Lawrence National Bank, Lawrence, Kansas, of the second part:

WITNESSETH That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand and 00 DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of section 36 Township 19 Range North, thence North East 9 chains, thence South 62 West 5 1/2 chains, thence West 4 chains to a point on the quarter section line; thence North 5 chains to the place of beginning more being 1/4 of the Northeast quarter of said section, also beginning at the northeast corner of the Northeast quarter of section 36 Township 19 Range 19, the north boundary line, thence West 10 1/2 rods, thence South 28 rods to the south line of said section, then East 11 1/2 rods to the place of beginning of said section; also beginning at the intersection of the north line of Missouri Street with the south line of 12th Street, extending North the west half to the bottom of land owned by Nahum H. Dinsmore, then South 4 rods east line thereof, East 13 feet to the west line of 22nd street, thence North by Missouri Street as aforesaid to the city of Lawrence to the place beginning 1/2 of an acre more or less, and North on said section 36 about 1/2 of a mile, Douglas County, Kansas, about North West 1/4 of section 36, tract four, half of the East half of section 36, being 1/2 of a mile from 12th Street to the city of Lawrence, Kansas, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parcels of the first part therein. And the said

First party, do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, excepting Mortgage for \$5000. on the First party's old chest property and \$2000. on the Property located at 10 and Missouri Street, Lawrence, Kansas.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen Thousand and 00 Dollars, according to the terms of this instrument, certain, stated, this day executed, to the said party of the second part, The Lawrence National Bank of Lawrence, Kansas, Being mortgaged for \$5000. cash Due January 1st 1924 - 5 - 6

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the second part, making such sale, on demand, to said

First party, their heirs and assigns.
