 of LAWRENCE, KANSAS, of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Seven hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do.....by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto said party of the second part, its successors and
 assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to-wit:-

The West 35 feet of Lot No. Forty-two (42) and the East Half of Lot
No. Forty Six (46) in Block (100) Street in Block No. Thirty
Six (36) in that part of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, as shown

TO HAVE AND HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or
 in any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of.....DOLLARS,
 with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the
 contract note secured hereby, advanced by the said THE Douglas County BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the parties of the first
 part upon.....7 shares of Class.....6 of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 3115 which said
 shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said
 shares, the first part.....agree.....to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$3.22, payable as follows.....
Twenty-two and 24/100 Dollars, (\$.....) on or before the last day of February, 1925,
 and a like sum on or before the 5th day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of January, 1928.

Now, if said parties of the first part shall cause to be paid to the party of the second part the amount due it under said contract note, in accordance
