WITNESSETH: That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto said party of the second part, its successors and
 assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot 11, Block 1, Subdivision 1, Lawrence, Kansas, containing One Hundred Twenty-nine (129) and One
Hundred Twenty-nine (129) sq. ft. of land, situated on Delaware Street and Lot Number
One Hundred One Hundred Twenty-nine (129) and One Hundred
Twenty-nine (129) sq. ft. of land, situated on Delaware Street in the City of Lawrence, Kas.

TO HAVE AND HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or
 in any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100 DOLLARS,
 with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the
 contract note secured hereby, advanced by the said THE Lawrence BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the part of the first
 part upon 7 1/2 shares of Class A of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 1449 which said
 shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said
