TO HAVE AND HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or
 in any wise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of..... DOLLARS,

Four hundred and no. DOLLARS,
 with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the
 contract note secured hereby, advanced by the said THE Douglas County BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the part 1st of the first
 part upon 4 shares of Class 6 of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 2132 which said
 shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said
 shares, the first part 1st agree to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$ 8.28, payable as follows:
Eight and 28/100 Dollars, (\$ 8.28) on or before the last day of August, 1922
 and a like sum on or before the 4th day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of June, 1927.
