PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure payment of the sum of.....

with interest and premium thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of the second part under the terms and conditions of the
contract note secured hereby, advanced by said THE Lawrence BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION to the part of the first
part upon 25 shares of Class 1 of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 492 which said
shares have been assigned to said Association with all future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest, premium and dues on said
shares, the first part do agree to pay in monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$ 36.75, payable as follows.....
Twenty-one 75..... Dollars, (\$ 31.75.....) on or before the last day of September 1922
and a like sum on or before the first day of each and every month thereafter to and including the month of August 1932

Now, if said part ⁰ ~~and~~ of the first part shall cause to be paid to the party of the second part the amount due it under said contract note, in accordance with the terms thereof, and comply with all the provisions and agreements in said note contained, then these presents shall be void; otherwise in full force and effect, and may be foreclosed as in said contract note provided.
