

PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

All that part of the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seventeen (17), in Township Thirteen (13) ~~North~~, of Range Nineteen (19) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, lying north of the Wakarusa Creek, containing 58.39 acres of land more or less, according to the Government survey thereof, located in Douglas County, Kansas,

from the lien of the mortgage dated December 19, 1917, executed by Carrie E. Cox, a widow, Glen Cox, single and Lee Cox, single, all being the heirs and only heirs at law of W. T.
