## EXTENSION AGREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT, between Frånk D. Wiggins and Ida L.Wiggins, his wife, (the first parties hereto), and the NEW YORK LIFF INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation of the State of New York ( the second party hereto), WITHERSETH:

To pay \$100 or multiple thereof on any interest paying date, provided, however, that if such payment or payments during any one year exceed one-fifth of the amount of the original note, a bonus of one -half of 1% per annum for the unexpired term of the loan shall be paid on such excess payment.
