

ASSIGNMENT

IN CONSIDERATION of the terms and of the conditions and agreements on the part of the KANSAS BAPTIST CONVENTION incorporated under the laws of the State of Kansas, hereinafter called the Convention, and set forth in the agreement made the 30th day of January, 1922, between said Convention and The American Baptist Home Mission Society, incorporated by an Act of The Legislature of the State of New York, hereinafter called the Society, said Society does hereby assign unto said Convention a certain mortgage made by the First Missionary Colored Baptist Church of Eudora dated the 27th day of March, 1896, and recorded on the 18th day of April, 1896, in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Douglas, in Mortgage Book number 31 at page 100 covering the premises in the town of Eudora in the County of Douglas, more particularly set forth in said mortgage.

And the said Society also assigns to said Convention a certain mortgage made by the First Regular Missionary Baptist Church of North Lawrence, dated the 16th day of March, 1898, and recorded on the 26th day of March, 1898, in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Douglas in Book number 33 of Mortgages at page 231 covering the premises in the town of North Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, more particularly set forth in said mortgage.

TOGETHER with the bonds, notes, or other obligations described in said mortgages and the monies due and to grow due thereon with interest;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE same unto the said Convention subject to the said terms conditions and agreements.
