do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they the lawful owners of the premises, above granted, and seized of a good and indefensible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

Twelve Hundred and no/100 Dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed by the said and delivered by Ethel Phillips and Fred Phillips to the said party of the second part. Said note being given for the sum of Twelve Hundred and no/100 Dollars, dated April 15, 1928, due and payable in eighteen months from date hereof with interest thereon from the date thereof until paid, according to the terms of said note, to the other party of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment or any part

thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole sum of one hundred and twenty dollars and six cents and interest unpaid thereon, and all taxes and interest unpaid thereon, and the same shall be paid by the party of the second part, to the other party of the second part, as executor or administrator and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the money arising from such sales to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said

heirs and assigns.
