#### KANSAS MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE, made the 12th day of April A.D. 1923 Between Jacob Scurle and Sophie E. Scurle his wife, of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, parties of the first part, and The Prudential Insurance Company of America, a body corporate, existing under and by virtue of the laws of New Jersey, and having its chief office in the City of Newark, and State of New Jersey, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH: That whereas the said parties of the first part are justly indebted to the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America for money borrowed in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to secure the payment of which they have executed one promissory note of even date herewith, payable on the 16th day of April A.D. 1928 being principal note, which note bears interest from April 18, 1923 at the rate of five per cent per annum, payable semi-annually. Said note is executed by said parties of the first part, and both principal and interest bear interest after maturity at the rate of ten per cent per annum, payable annually, until paid, and is made payable to the order of said The Prudential Insurance Company of America, at its office in the City of Newark, New Jersey.

NOW, THEREFORE THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the premises, and for the purpose of securing the payment of the money aforesaid and interest thereon according to the tenor and effect of the said promissory above mentioned, and also to secure the faithful performance of all the covenants conditions, stipulations and agreements herein contained, do by these presents mortgage and warrant unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, forever, all the following described lands and premises, situated, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the South Thirty Seven and one-half (37 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres of the West Sixty (60) acres of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) except twenty five (25) feet off the East side of said last described tract for road, all in Section Seven (7) Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Twenty One (21) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, containing Seventy Seven and one half (77 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres more or less.

AND the said parties of the first part expressly agree to pay, said note and the interest thereon.
