Steele, his wife, of Lawrence, Douglas County, state of Kansas, mortgagors, hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and mortgage unto Kansas City Joint Stock Land Bank of Kansas City, Missouri a Corporation organized and existing under an act of Congress of the United States of America known as the Federal Farm Loan Act, with its principal office in Kansas City, in the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, mortgagee, the d following described real estate situated in Douglas County, Kansas, to-wit: The South half of the of the East two-thirds of the Southeast Quarter of section 7, Township 13, Range 19, Douglas County, Kansas, less that part of the above described land lying east of the Lawrence and Emporia State road, and less railroad right-of-way, containing approximately 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres. Also the South half of the Southwest fractional quarter of section 7 Township 13, Range 19, Douglas County Kansas, less 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of railroad right-of-way, and containing approximately 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres.
