This Mortgage made the 1st day of June A.D. 1924, Between Minnie A. Taylor, a widow of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, party of the first part, and THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, a body corporate, existing under and by virtue of the laws of New Jersey, and having its chief office in the City of Newark and State of New Jersey, party of the second part,

Witnesseth, That whereas the said party of the first part is justly indebted to THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, for money borrowed in the sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS, to secure the payment of which she has executed one promissory note of even date herewith, for FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS, payable on or before the first day of June 1929, with interest from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, payable monthly; being an installment note by the terms of which the said party of the first part agree to pay to THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, or order monthly on the first day of each month, until the date of maturity of said note, the sum of Twenty Five Dollars, to be applied on the principal of said note, with interest, at the same time as each installment of principal at the rate of six per centum per annum, on the balances of principal of said note remaining unpaid on the first day of each month, and pay the unpaid principal of said note on the date of maturity thereof.

Said note executed by the said party of the first part, and bears interest after maturity at the rate of ten per cent per annum, payable annually, until paid, and is made payable to the order of said THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA at its office, in the City of Newark, New Jersey.

Now, Therefore, this indenture Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the premises, and for the purpose of securing the payment of the money aforesaid and interest thereon according to the tenor and effect of the said promissory note above mentioned, and also to secure the faithful performance of all the covenants, conditions, stipulations and agreements herein contained, does by these presents, mortgage and warrant unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all the following described lands and premises, situated and being in the City of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:
