THIS INDENTURE, Made this 9th day of January  
 Bursha White Brown and John Henry Brown, her husband  
 of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and The Lawrence Building and Loan Association of Lawrence,  
 Kansas, of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said part ies of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ DOLLARS,  
 Three Hundred Fifty and no/100  
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto said party of the second part, its successors and  
 assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, to-wit:

The west one half (1/2) of lot number twenty seven (27) in Addition number eleven (11)  
 in that part of the City of Lawrence known as North Lawrence.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or  
 in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure the payment of the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ DOLLARS,  
 Three Hundred Fifty and no/100  
 with interest thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of second part under the terms and conditions of the contract note secured  
 hereby, advanced by the said The Lawrence Building and Loan Association to the part ies of the  
 first part upon 3/4 shares of Class G of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 800, which said shares  
 have been assigned to said Association with all the future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest and dues on said shares, the first part ies  
 agree to pay monthly installments, making a total monthly payment of \$ 11.13, payable as follows:  
 Eleven and 13/100 Dollars (\$ 11.13)  
 on or before the last day of January, 1925, and a like sum on or before the last day of each and every  
 month thereafter to and including the month of December, 1927.

Now, if said part ies of the first part shall cause to be paid to the party of the second part the amount due it under said contract note, in accord-  
 ance with the terms thereof, and comply with all the provisions and agreements in said note contained, then these presents shall be void; otherwise in full force  
 and effect, and may be foreclosed as in said contract note provided.
