Whereas: All of said First Mortgage Four per cent Gold Bonds issued by said The Union Pacific Land Company and secured by its said first Mortgage have been cancelled and the debt, both principal and interest, secured by said First Mortgage has been fully satisfied.

Now Therefore, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to the said Bankers Trust Company in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged said Bankers Trust Company does hereby acknowledge and certify that the said First Mortgage of said The Union Pacific Land Company, dated June 28, 1898, to the Mercantile Trust Company, as Trustee, has been satisfied and discharged and does hereby satisfy, discharge and release all and singular the property and premises embraced in said Mortgage from the lien and charge created and arising by reason of said Mortgage, and does hereby consent that the said Mortgage be cancelled and discharged of record.
