Davis, his wife, of the county of Douglas, and State of Kansas, parties of the first part, and GROVES BROTHERS, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, having its office and principal place of business in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Forty-five Hundred and no/100 ----- DOLLARS, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained and Sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm, unto the said party of the second part, and its successors and assigns forever, all of the following-described tract, piece, or parcel of land, lying and situate in the county of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to-wit:
