## FIRST MORTGAGE BOND.

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, The Lawrence Sanitary Swimming Pool Company, incorporated under the laws of the State of Kansas, promises to pay to bearer or, in case this bond is registered, to the registered holder thereof, Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in lawful money of the United States of America, at The Lawrence National Bank in Lawrence, Kansas, on the 15th day of May, 1927, and to pay interest thereon in like tender at the rate of Six and one-half Per Cent (6½%) Per Annum from date on present-ation and surrender of the annexed coupons as they become due on the 15th day of November and May in each year after date until such principal shall be fully paid.

This Bond is one of a series of Twenty bonds, numbered from 1 to 20, inclusive, being an issue of a total of bonds of the aggregate par value of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00) comprising four bonds of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) each, six bonds of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each, and ten bonds of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each, and a part of which matures each year beginning with the year 1928 and the last of which matures May 15th 1936; said issue being duly authorized by the stockholders and directors of said Company at meetings called and held as required by the by-laws. All of said bonds are secured by and entitled to the benefits and subject to the provisions of a first mortgage in the form of a deed of trust, dated May 16th, 1927, made by said Company to The Lawrence National Bank, of Lawrence, Kansas, as trustee, and reference is specially made to the provisions of said deed of trust.

Without regard to the maturity of said bonds, the Company expressly reserves the right to redeem at any time after May 15th 1930, any or all of said bonds then outstanding by the payment of the interest accrued to the date of such redemption and One Hundred and Two Per Cent (102%) of the par value of said bonds, all as set out in said deed of trust.

This bond may be registered on the books of said trustee and the registration noted upon this bond by the bond registrar of The Lawrence National Bank, the trustee, after which no valid transfer hereof can be made except on said books until after registered transfer to bearer, but registration shall not affect nor restrain negotiation of the coupons by delivery merely.

This bond shall not be valid until the certificate endorsed hereon shall have been executed by the trustee.
