Vialle of the City of Boston and State of Massachusetts Trustee party of the second part,

Witnesseth; Whereas the party of the first part is the owner of and is now operating a telephone line with exchanges and telephone poles, piers, abutments wires and appurtenances magnets bells, switchboards, and appurtenances as follows; At Abilene, Dickinson County, Kansas 180 poles, 15 miles of wire, 65 magnets bells, and 2 switchboards in general office; At Arkansas City, Cowley County Kansas 120 poles, 15 miles of wire, 30 magnets bells, and 1 switchboard in central office; at Burlingame, Osage County, Kansas 75 poles 10 miles of wire, 30 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in central office; at Burlington, Coffey County Kansas 75 poles, 7 miles of wire, 30 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in central office; at Butler, Bates County, Missouri 60 poles & miles of wire, 30 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in central office; at Caldwell, Sumner County, Kansas 60 poles & miles of wire, 25 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in central office; at Carthage, Jasper County, Missouri 150 poles, 15 miles of wire, 55 magnets bells and two switchboards in general office; at Clay Center, Clay County, Kansas 120 poles, 14 miles of wire, 45 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in general office; at Emporia Lyon County Kansas 175 poles, 20 miles of wire, 70 magnets bells and 2 switchboards in general office; at Fort Scott Bourbon County Kansas 150 poles, 15 miles of wire, 60 magnets bells and 2 switchboards in general office; at Galena Cherokee County Kansas 60 poles, 6 miles of wire, 25 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in general office; at Joplin, Jasper County Missouri, 60 poles, 10 miles of wire, 25 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in general office; at Junction City, Davis County Kansas 200 poles, 20 miles of wire, 80 magnets bells and 3 switchboards in central office; at Lawrence Douglas County, Kansas 250 poles, 30 miles of wire, 105 magnets bells and 3 switchboards in central office; at Nevada, Vernon County, Missouri 120 poles, 15 miles of wire, 45 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in central office; at Newton Harvey County, Kansas, 120 poles, 15 miles of wire, 45 magnets bells and 1 switchboard in central office; at

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
