 extending its lines said party of the first part is desirous
 of borrowing money and has resolved to execute and
 ultimately issue the bonds of said Company for the

 the aggregate to One Hundred Thousand dollars, each of
 said bonds to be dated on the 15th day of April 1884
 and to bear interest at the rate of seven per cent per
 annum payable semi annually on the 15th day of
 October and April of each and every year both principal
 and interest payable at the National Bank of the Republic
