This indenture made this twenty second day of June  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty three between Larrie Eldridge and Shaler  
W. Eldridge her husband of Lawrence in the County of  
Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and  
D. E. Gearnard of the second part;

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in  
consideration of the sum One Thousand Dollars to them  
duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and mortgage to the said party of the second part his his  
and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land  
situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas  
described as follows to wit;

Lots nos. One (1) Two (2) Three (3) Thirty two (32) Thirty  
three (33) and Thirty four (34) all in Block no. Seventeen (17)  
of Babcock's Addition to the City of Lawrence  
Douglas County Kansas according to the plat of said  
addition with the appurtenances and all the estate title  
and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.

And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant  
and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the  
lawful owners of the premises above granted and  
seized of any good and indefeasible estate of inheritance  
therein free and clear of all incumbrances, and

This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the
