

of such sale to retain the principal, and interest of all sums then due the costs and charges of such vendue and sale and also the attorney fees hereinafter provided, rendering the surplus money (if any there should be) to the said parties of the first part their heirs executors or administrators.

And it is further expressly agreed that as often as any proceeding is taken to foreclose this mortgage either by virtue of the above power of sale in Chancery or in any other manner provided by law said first parties shall pay said second party Fifty Dollars as a reasonable solicitor or attorney fee therefor in addition to all other legal costs.
