

contained to the contrary notwithstanding such election to
be made at any time after the expiration of three days
without notice, show if the said parties of the first
part shall will and truly pay or cause to be paid the
said sum of money in said note mentioned with
the interest thereon according to the tenor and
effect of said note then these presents shall be null
and void. But if said sum of Money or any interest
thereon is not paid when the same is due and
payable or if any taxes or assessments levied against
said property are not paid when the same are
payable or if default shall be made in the agree-
ment to keep said premises insured as hereinafter
set forth then in either of these cases the whole of said
sum mentioned in said note together with the interest
thereon shall and by this indenture does immediately
become due and payable at the option of the party
of the party of the second part or his assigns to be
at any time thereafter exercised without notice to
the parties of the first part; but the legal holder of
this mortgage may at his option pay or cause to be
paid the said taxes and assessments so due and
payable and such premiums and charge for
insurance as the mortgagors or their assigns shall
neglect or refuse to pay as hereafter set forth and
charge them against said parties of the first part and
the amounts so charged shall be an additional sum
upon the said mortgaged property and may be
enforced and collected in the same manner as the
principal debt hereby secured together with interest
at the rate of ten per cent. per cent per annum
payable semi-annually until fully paid and
discharged, but whether the party of the second
part elect to pay such taxes assessments and
insurances or not it is distinctly understood that in
all cases of delinquencies as above enumerated then
in like manner the said note and the whole of
said sum shall immediately become due and
payable and said mortgagee or his assigns may
immediately cause this mortgage to be foreclosed
and shall be entitled to the immediate possession
of the premises and the rents issues and profits
