Stone his wife of LeCompton in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Lane University of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Eighty five  $\frac{57}{100}$  Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part its and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit;

Lots numbered Eight (8) Nine (9) Ten (10) Eleven (11) Twelve (12) Twenty three (23) in Block numbered Eighteen (18) in the City of LeCompton according to the published plat thereof, with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
