This Indenture made this 1st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four between George Hollingbery and Mary Jane Hollingbery (husband and wife) of Wakarusa Township in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and William Hollingbery of the second part;

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and fifty (\$250.00) Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit;

All that part or portion of the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section No. Twenty (20) in Township No. Thirteen (13) of Range No. Twenty (20) lying and being West of the track of the Leavenworth Lawrence and Babston Rail road containing four (4) acres more or less with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said George Hollingbery and Mary Jane Hollingbery (husband
