

cent in any suit for foreclosure of this mortgage and it shall be lawful for the party of the second part his executor administrators and assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by law appraisement waived or not at the option of the party of the second part and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due or to become due according to the conditions of this instrument and interest at twelve per cent per annum from the time of said default until paid together with the costs and charges of making such sale and a reasonable attorneys fee for the foreclosure of this mortgage to be taxed as other costs in the suit.
