Provided Always and these presents are upon this express condition that whereas the said John B. King is justly indebted unto the said Mary J. Smith in the principal sum of Four Hundred and fifty Dollars lawful money of the United State of America being for loan thereof in the day and date hereof made by the said Mary J. Smith to the said John B. King and secured to be paid by the certain promissory note of the said John B. King bearing even date herewith payable to the order of the said Mary J. Smith with twenty eight months from the date thereof at the office of Wm. T. Sinclair in the City of Lawrence and State of Kansas with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum from date until said principal sum is fully paid said interest to be paid semi-annually on the first day of June 1885 and 1886 said several installments of interest being further specified by interest notes or coupons of even date herewith attached to each of said notes and payable at said Wm. T. Sinclair's office in the City of Lawrence Kansas. And in and by said promissory notes it is agreed that if default be made in the payment of any one of the installments of interest aforesaid at the time and place aforesaid then at the election of the legal holder of said notes the said principal sum of Four Hundred and fifty Dollars
